A "Törggele evening", a typical Thanksgiving feast celebrated in the south Tyrol, will be a moment of pure pleasure for all.

For this event, a participation fee of €120,- wil be charged. Half-board accommodation is available at the convention centre, Kloster Neustift, for €55,per day.
